Our Wins

1. Celebrating with Church Planters Since June 2022, the Saradise Church plant in Kuching started meeting regularly to study the word in a small group.

This came after months of relationshipbuilding and regular gatherings at the park and at home. The Lord has also provided a meeting place in September.



MEETING AT NO COST

Grace Life Community Church at Kota Kemuning began gathering to worship on the first Sunday of the month since September. New friends started to join the pre-launch service which took place in November.

In addition, a Christmas open house event brought in neighbours and friends interested to learn about Christ. Grace Life Community Church plans to start meeting weekly from January 2023 and to launch as a church in February.





The **New Covenant City Church** in Penang has grown from 23 to 34 members by the end of 2022. Regular Sunday service attendance is about 45, led by three elders.

2. Launched Gospel Bites and Friday Digest

Free monthly Gospel Bites were introduced, with educational videos that focused on the topics of the free Book of the month. Bi-monthly email broadcasts were also used to reach those not on social media platforms.

Key Challenges

- Since August, we have not been able to replace the headcount as workload continues to increase. In addition, one of our team recently left for maternity leave, further reducing the team to four.
- There has been a decline in registrations for online-training and conferences. GCN is evaluating online versus in-person events and exploring creative ways to attract and engage the audience.
- GCN is making slow and steady progress towards builing a citywide collaborative effort.

English Ministry Highlights

1. Valley 2040

 A dinner with key pastors was held to help build momentum, and we look forward to having two to three meetings in 2023 to continue discussing collaborative church planting.



2. Training

 Six participants completed the course with their Philosophy of Ministries, ready to be implemented.



Gospel Labs

GCN worked with two local churches and provided training towards renewal. As a result, leadership from one participating church has requested additional training for 2023.

The other church has signed up for a Re-Visioning workshop with GCN as they seek to re-imagine what they want to be and achieve.







Short Courses (Gospel Bites)


Six Gospel Bites were produced and published. These resources published on the 15th of the month, come with a series of short videos with an accompanying book.



Online Webinars (Gospel Bungkus)

 Two free online webinars, Gospel Bungkus, were offered on Sonship and Renewal.

A smaller group showed up for each of the webinars. However, the interaction was spontaneous and free.



Courses in the Pipeline

 GCN did not offer any new paid courses in the last six months as we focused on gaining traction.

Nonetheless, we recorded four new asynchronous courses to be edited and published in 2023. These include training in Gospel Theology, Gospel Renewal, Discipleship, and Faith and Work.




Praying Cohort

The launch of a Praying Cohort has been postponed to February 2023 as there was a change in the trainer's availability and travel plans to KL.

Introduction to ReVision

 Rev Dr Andrew Katay shared to a small team in KL about the ReVisioning and Revitalisation work in Australia.

The local team had an enjoyable time discussing different cultural issues and how they might adapt to the audience here.

Preaching Cohort

Fifty-six people registered for a two-day preaching seminar in October. Five signed up for a follow-on preaching cohort scheduled to start in 2023.





Malaysia Baptist Convention Pastors' Seminar

■ The MBC hosted a conference for the Baptist churches in Malaysia. This year saw fifty-six registrants from the Peninsular.

Rev Gideon Lim and Dr Kyle Essary each preached a sermon on Gospel Rest in Mandarin and English, respectively.



GCN put up a table introducing the various training offered. A number signed up for our newsletters and online resources on the spot.

Developing a Collaborative Model for City-Wide Church Planting

■ This is a follow-up event to the *Klang Valley Church Planting Dialogue* in June 2022. Participants discussed various training paths to address the stubborn facts identified during the dialogue.



For the first time in two years, all our events for the past six months have been in-person.

4. Content

- Gospel Bites
 - Six monthly releases of video content with monthly releases of free ebooks in partnership with Crossway Publishing were rolled out.

Landing pages for multilingual resources

 Landing pages for Tim Kellers' sermons with subtitles in local languages were set up (as CTC Redeemer make these available)

We anticipate having languagespecific pages as more content is created and translated in local languages.



5. GCN Parakaleo

 The leadership team has prepared six women to be trained to facilitate small groups. An in-person seminar was held, giving a taste of Parakaleo with twelve attendees. As a result, one additional small group has been set up to support growing needs.



Priorities for the Next Six Months

Training

- GCN is in conversation with a local seminary to have the Incubator accredited by the Asia Theological Association.
- GCN will host and run a two-week Intensive for church planters in Kuala Lumpur in June, on behalf of CTC AP. GCN will take point on the operation and training for this.
- GCN will equip a local team of consultants to facilitate re-visioning workshops for participating churches with follow-on Gospel Labs.
- GCN will be kicking off training for facilitators of praying cohorts with SeeJesus Ministry. A physical meet-and-greet session with Jon Hori will take place in February.

Events

- Kings and Covenant Conference in collaboration with Third
 Millennium. This conference will be in Mandarin and English.
- Free webinars (Gospel Bungkus) will continue to be offered for the public so they get to know GCN and the training offered.

Content

- Two short paid courses will be offered the first half of the year.
- Free ebooks with carefully curated content or Gospel Bites will be rolled out every month.
- Monthly blog posts will be published, giving more visibility to the Mandarin Ministry and Parakaleo Ministry.
