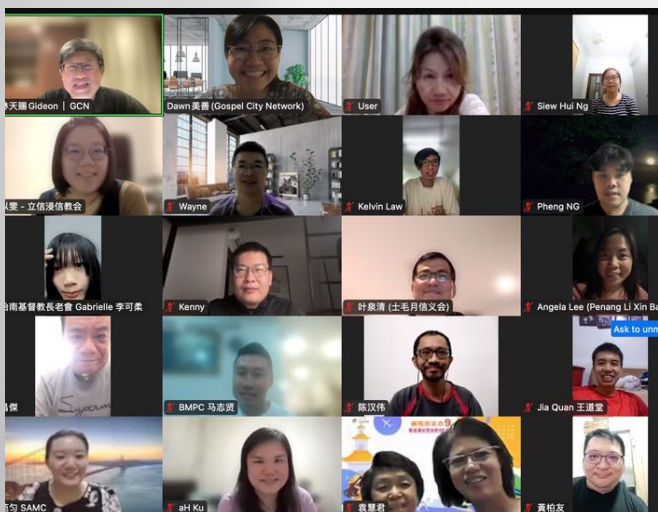

MULTIPLICATION

We believe that true transformation comes through the Gospel of Jesus Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit and grounded in the truths of Scripture, with the church as the primary vehicle for spreading and embodying the gospel. By training, equipping, and encouraging church planters and mission-minded leaders, we aim to foster vibrant, healthy churches driven by deep faith, repentance, and a fresh grasp of God's grace—resulting in flourishing communities and reproducing churches that renew hearts, churches, and cities.

ACTIVITIES

Training: The Incubator, the Intensive, and the Gospel DNA are our flagship trainings, each designed to equip and support church planters, mission-minded leaders, and church revitalisers through diverse formats and timelines.

Local Church: We offer ReVision workshops to align the local church with a common mission, articulating their God-given calling and fostering consensus on how to achieve it. In two days, the workshop identifies goals, interventions, and programmes to actualise the envisioned future.

Ministry-Minded Women: Through Parakaleo Malaysia, we support women in ministry by creating safe spaces for them to share challenges and equipping them with practical theology and tools to stay resilient amidst the demands of ministry and everyday life.

Gospel Renewal: We engage the city with gospel-centred content through short webinars, in-person seminars, and free resources, providing accessible learning experiences.

Training

- In March, 121 participants, comprising church planters, pastors, and ministry leaders completed Part 1 of our Mini Intensive programme. We ran three tracks at the same time in Penang: English, Mandarin, Parakaleo BASIC. We're grateful for the opportunity to train these leaders and look forward to continuing the journey in Part 2 this October.

Local Church

- Following the Mini Intensive, we held a two-day Gospel DNA training in Johor Bahru with three congregations from a local church. As one of our core training programmes, it guides leaders to explore the gospel's implications for both their lives and their churches.

Ministry-Minded Women

- Over the last six months, we held two *Taste of Parakaleo* sessions introducing women to God's "omni" attributes—His omnipresence, omniscience, and omnipotence—and their calling as ezer: helpers who draw strength from Him. A key milestone was launching our first BASIC Intensive in Penang, where nine ministry-minded women were equipped with gospel tools for life and ministry.

PARAKALEO BASIC PARTICIPANT FEEDBACK

"I've been given a set of tools to help me **put on a gospel lens**—to see myself and others more clearly, and to help others understand that they were created to be loved by God and to have a relationship with Him. God also brought together a group of sisters who were willing to be vulnerable and **share so authentically**. That community helped us learn how to apply the gospel tools."

Gospel Renewal

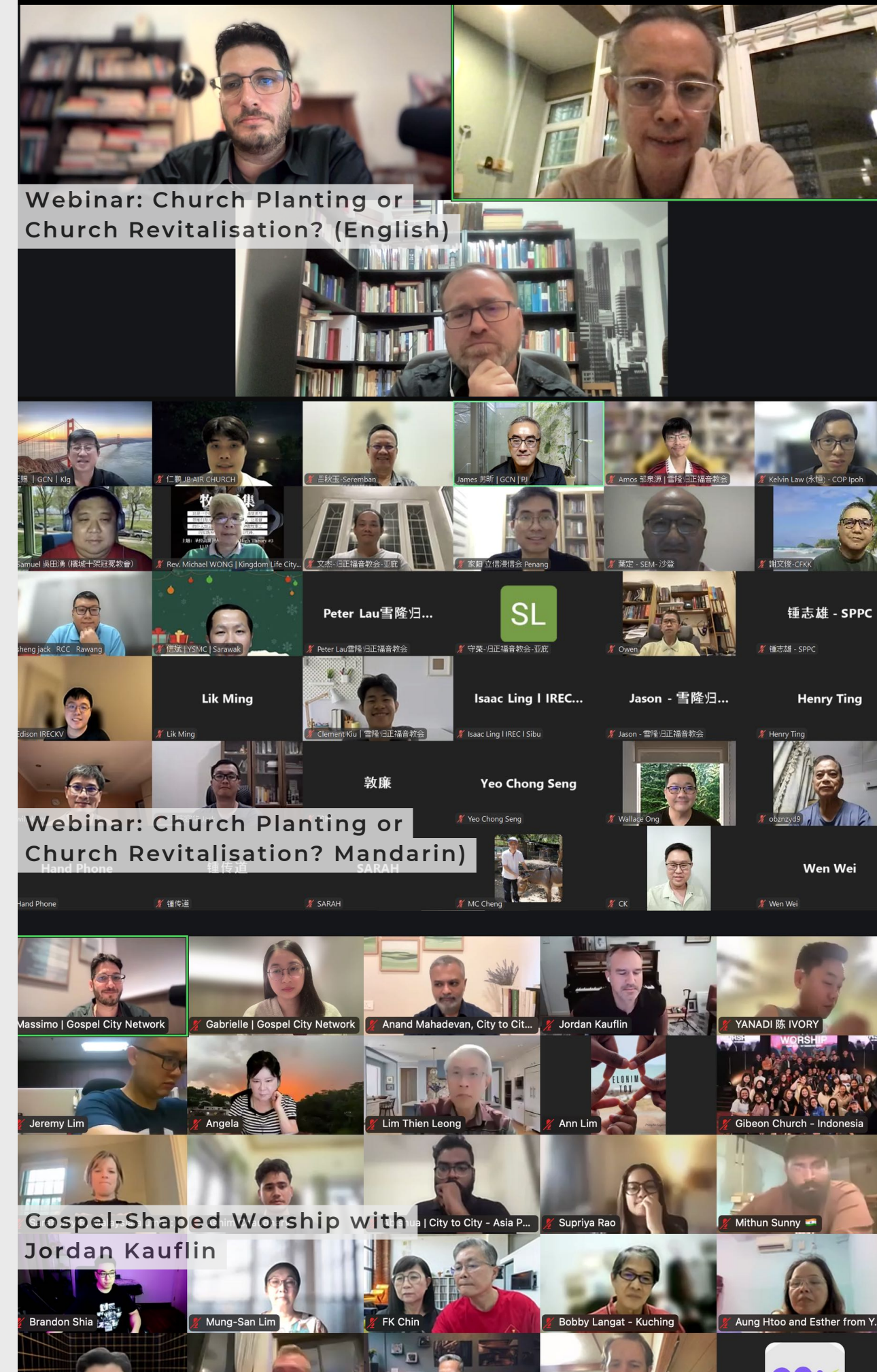
- In February, we hosted English and Mandarin webinars exploring whether Malaysian churches should focus on planting new churches or revitalising existing ones—highlighting the value of both and offering guidance on how to discern which path best suits a church's particular context.
- In April, we partnered with City to City Asia Pacific for a Gospel-Shaped Worship webinar with Jordan Kauflin. He addressed key questions on designing gospel-centred worship and leadership.
- We also ran a one-hour Mandarin webinar on *Forgiveness*, reflecting on Christ's forgiveness and introducing the heart of our ministry DNA.

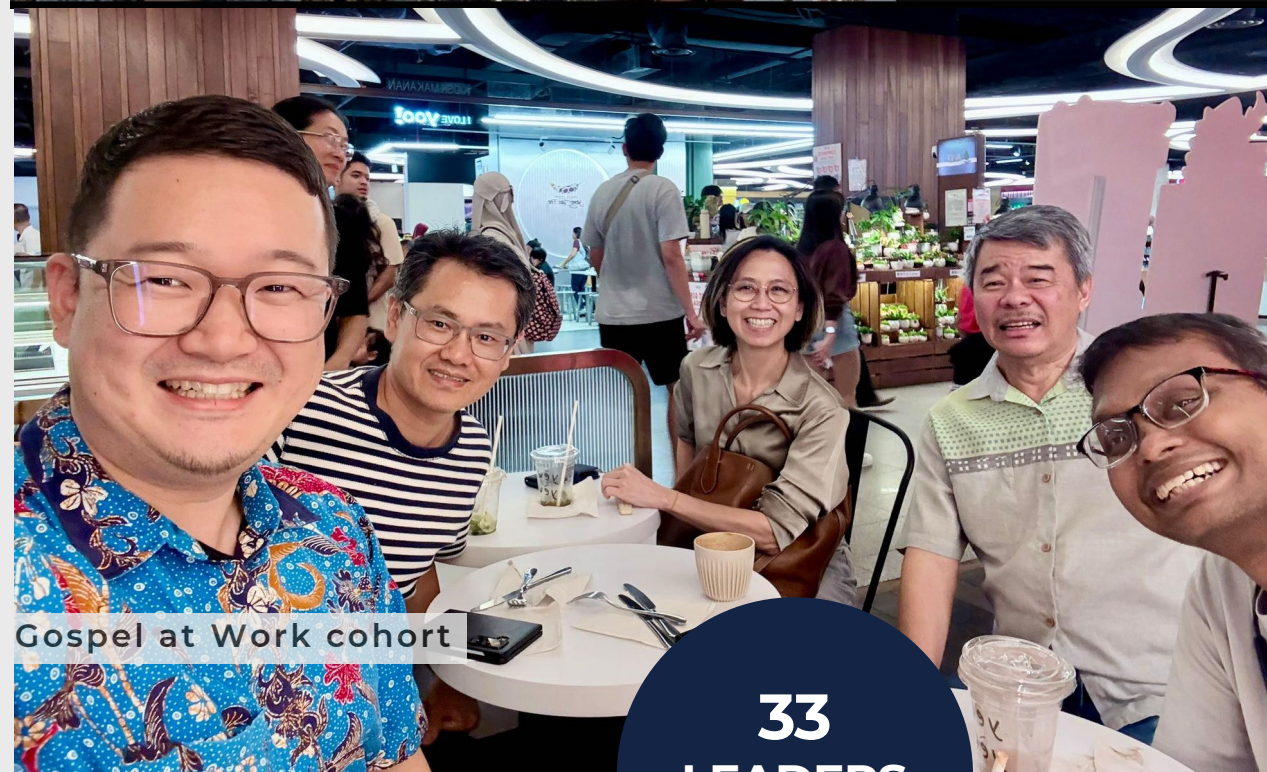

HIGHLIGHTS



- In February, our Faith and Work catalyst, Joonseok, launched the second online Gospel at Work cohort—a small group designed to help Christian workers apply gospel truths like heart change and repentance in the workplace. The cohort was marked by rich diversity and deep, gospel-shaped conversations that fostered meaningful connections beyond the sessions.
- A pastor who joined the 2024 Gospel at Work cohort invited our team to lead a Gospel DNA session focused on the marketplace, gathering 25 key leaders from 13 churches in their network. We praise God for the shared heart of these leaders and look forward to walking with them as they shape a Faith and Work ministry vision through ongoing training.

HIGHLIGHTS



- **Praxis:** In our KL Praxis gathering, pastors took part in a *Neighbourhood Pulse* mapping activity, identifying values and struggles in their church neighbourhoods. This hands-on session helped surface patterns of brokenness and renewal, encouraging churches to respond thoughtfully to urban needs.
- **Klang Valley Church Planting Dialogue:** We addressed the ongoing challenge of poor gospel fluency and biblical literacy, with 22 leaders from 12 churches across 8 denominations contributing practical strategies and insights to deepen discipleship in their contexts. We collaborate with international publishers and local authors to make gospel-centred resources accessible and affordable in Malaysia and neighbouring countries. By offering a mix of printed and digital resources, we seek to nurture gospel growth in the city.

HIGHLIGHTS



- ***Translation Projects***: Translation efforts continue to expand resources in Bahasa Malaysia (BM) and Mandarin (CN), with several books completed, others in progress, and *Truth for Life* articles being translated into BM.
- ***Partnerships***: We've seen growing interest in our pop-up bookstore, expanding from just a few tables to 6–8 tables of gospel-centred titles. This year, we've engaged with various church camps and conferences across Malaysia and Singapore, offering a wider range of resources to more communities.
- ***E-book Availability***: Through our monthly free e-book giveaways, 939 e-books were downloaded.
- ***Other Highlights***: We shared the BM translation of *Seeing and Savouring Christ* by John Piper with Komuniti Digital, ran a Little Good Sheep online book sale, and had trainer Adam Graig speak at the Singapore Baptist Convention.



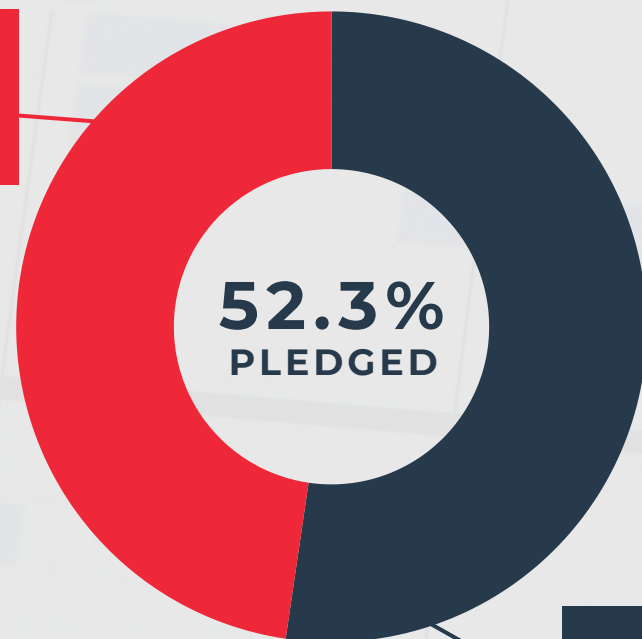

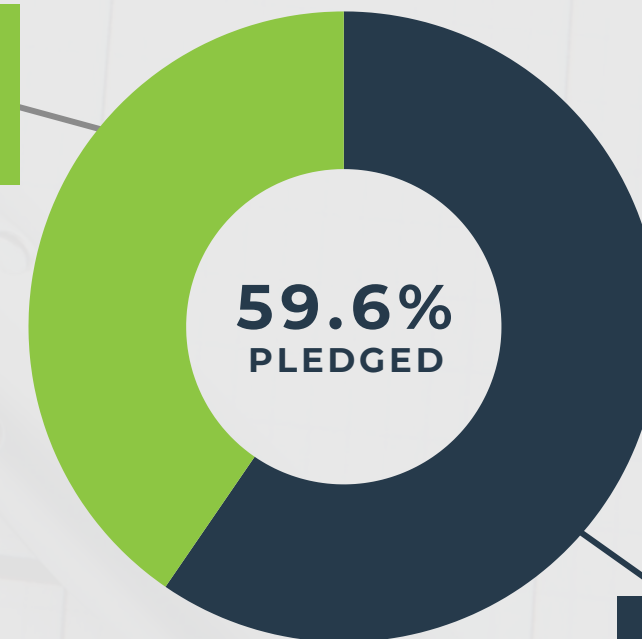
